The Most Outstanding Student Award is the school's highest award for our IBDP graduates who excelled academically and made significant contributions to the school and community.

### SHI XIN YING KAITLYN



After achieving outstanding results in her Cambridge IGCSE subjects, Kaitlyn has continued to demonstrate the same commitment to achieve excellence in the rigorous and demanding International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP). Being one of the most prominent student leaders with various distinguished positions of responsibilities in her final secondary school years, Kaitlyn has shown an extraordinary ability to balance her leadership responsibilities and the high demands of her IBDP studies. With self-motivation, determination and resilience, Kaitlyn achieved a truly outstanding IBDP score of 44 out of 45, with various top-of-the-class achievements in various subjects.

As the president of the Athletic Council (AC) in Academic Year 1819, Kaitlyn Shi has impacted the council and the school community in truly transformative ways.
